#### President's Message

Dr. Kenneth Sewell, vice president for research at OSU, was the speaker at the April Monday Night Dinner. He reaffirmed OSU's commitment to Land Grant concerns and referred to much of this work as Public Impact Research as it focuses on the improvement of communities OSU serves.

Dr. Sewell described our Tier One Research Initiatives as

- 1. Drone initiative—serving our safety and environment
- 2. Microbione initiative—connecting to health concerns
- 3. Opioid initiative—research arm of wellness and recovery
- 4. Rural renewal initiative—ensuring future of rural Oklahoma

Dr. Sewell indicated much interdisciplinary research is now being conducted.

Other high-impact research areas he mentioned include the following:

Energy, Aerospace, Feeding the World, Water-energy Nexus, Childhood Adversity, One Health, and Disciplinary Prowess.

He also mentioned "the Conversation" in which research topics, articles, etc., are broadly shared (including to media) and with Iron Monk in downtown Stillwater that has even tried an on-site interactive program entitled "Research on Tap." Sewell reminded the audience of the

value and significance of undergrad research and used the Niblack Scholars program as an example and pointed toward the upcoming Undergraduate Research Program, April 19, in the Alumni Center. He ended his presentation by answering several questions from members of the audience.
