Walter Scott, 95, was born on December 22, 1928, and passed away on January 25, 2024. He taught in the Philosophy Department for nearly 40 years, where he often taught the Philosophy of Religion and the Logic courses. His scholarly interests centered on medieval philosophy. Walter earned two degrees from Baylor University where he met a young lady, Doris Jones, who would become his wife. In addition, he had two degrees from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and earned his doctorate at the Johns Hopkins University. Walter and Doris were married in July 1950. She passed away in 2017. They raised two daughters, Lori Jane Scott (Glenn) Robinson and Gaye Lynn Scott. Walter was a long-time member of the First Baptist Church in Stillwater for over 60 years, sang in the church choir for nearly 60 years, and taught Sunday School for 50 of those years. He also held a number of leadership positions in the First Baptist Church, including service as a deacon. He is survived by his two daughters, Lori Robinson and Gaye Lynn Scott, son-in-law (Glenn Robinson), and grandson, Joel.
