## Announcement

Shortly, you should be receiving from Blue Cross/Blue Shield information regarding the 2021 plans for OSU retirees. All retirees who have a BC/BS Individual Medicare Supplement Plan will be required to submit a new enrollment form for supplemental medical plans to either identify the plan of choice (3 different plans) or to decline future coverage. Retirees who currently have Medicare Part D (Rx) coverage are not required to submit a new enrollment form if they wish to keep their current plan. However, retirees who wish to change their Part D plan will need to submit a new enrollment form. The open enrollment period runs from October 12-30, with new coverage beginning January 1, 2021.
