Substantive v. Non-Substantive

Examples of substantive program modifications:

- Changing the total credit hours for the program
- Adding or removing required courses
- Increasing or decreasing the number of elective credit hours
- Changing a course number that results in a change in credit hours
- Adding or removing admission or graduation requirements

Examples of non-substantive program modifications:

- Adding or removing courses from a list of electives
- Course prefix changes
- Course title changes
- Changing a course number that does not result in a change in credit hours
