BENEFIT REMINDERS

OSU Health Insurance Annual Enrollment

The 2016 Annual Benefits Enrollment period for **retirees and spouses under age 65** will be from **October 1 through October 16, 2015**. OSU Human Resources Benefits mailed information last week to your home address. If you elect to make changes, the changes will be effective January 1, 2016.

Annual Enrollment for Medicare Rx (**retirees and spouses age 65 and older**) is **October 15 through December 7**. OSU Human Resources Benefits will mail information on about October 10. Plan 65, the Blue Cross Medicare supplement plan, can be changed at any time.

Information regarding dental or vision insurance through the State will be mailed directly from them.

Parking

OSU Retirees with 20 years or more consecutive OSU Stillwater service and 20 consecutive years of obtaining an OSU parking permit are entitled to receive a retiree parking permit. Please note the expiration for parking permits has been changed to August 14, so mark your calendars now for next year's renewal.
