Phishing Scams

The OSU campus has been under attack due to phishing scams. Many individuals have received emails with a request that you click a link embedded in the message that will take you to your O-Key account where you can obtain important information. Many of the emails used in these phishing scams appear to be sent from fellow OSU employees and in many cases are indicating that HR is needing something. These are not valid requests.

Be safe and never provide password/access information through an embedded email link.

They appear to look like the ones you received earlier and the identification numbers are the same. However, the coverage information has been updated.
